



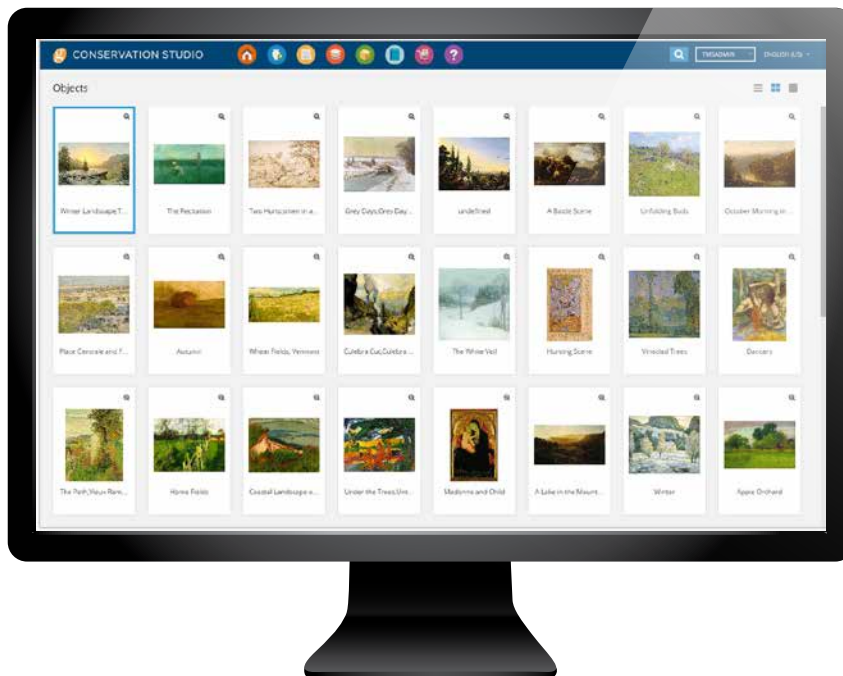

TMS Conservation Studio is an easy-to-navigate web-based tool designed to support conservation work. Conservation Studio integrates with The Museum System (TMS) to streamline your conservation processes, and consolidate project management, scientific information, treatment data, surveys, reporting, and image management. Users can access their data securely from any computer, anywhere.

## Objects

View your objects from a fresh, conservation-based perspective. Capture and display relevant information such as medium, dimensions, and environmental requirements. Access an object's entire conservation history from one central place.



## Projects

Easily manage complex conservation projects by attaching all related elements from objects, examination and treatment reports, loans and exhibitions into a consolidated, searchable data-set. Track the work of multiple conservators, view assignments, and create status alerts.



## Conservation Reports

Access individual conservation reports and create and link specialized reports to their related objects, media, conservator and projects. With configurable data forms and fields, all reports are fully customizable to suit the requirements of various conservation specialties (i.e., paper, textiles, paintings, time-based media, etc.). Increase the efficiency of your reporting processes with report templates. You can even query your conservation data to see specific condition issues and more.

## Constituents

Constituent records can be cross-referenced with other modules within Conservation Studio and TMS. Link yourself (and other conservators) as Constituents to easily access your conservation reports and projects.



## Media

Link media records to the Conservation Reports module. Store before, during and after photos of object treatments. Conservation reports can be accessed directly from within related media records.



## Exhibitions & Loans

Link related exhibition and loan records to Conservation Studio's Projects module to view current exhibition plans. You can even access records remotely when traveling.



## Bibliography

Link TMS's bibliography records to Conservation Reports to record related research references and track papers and publications. View bibliography references and citations linked to object records.

## TMS COMPATIBLE

Conservation Studio is integrated with TMS, ensuring easy and consistent access to your data. Collaboration with non-conservation colleagues is made simple using a centralized, interrelated system. Conservation Studio integrates the user security settings already established in your TMS database, and protects your conservation information accordingly.

## CONFIGURABLE EXPERIENCE

With fully configurable fields, forms, and screen views, you can easily create a Conservation Studio experience tailored to your specific conservation discipline and role. View assignments, projects, and upcoming tasks from the configurable dashboard for a time-saving overview of your conservation activities.

## SIMPLIFIED DOCUMENTATION

Use tailored conservation report templates to document activities such as condition and treatment reports, treatment proposals, surveys, scientific analyses and complex installation works with data elements specific to your discipline. Report data is indexed and searchable and can be used for research analysis, to track projects, and to generate statistics. All list displays can be easily exported to Excel.

## WEB-BASED

Conservation Studio is completely web-based, giving you full access to your conservation information and uninterrupted workflow via computers or laptops whether you're working in the gallery or on the road.

## IMAGE ANNOTATION

Conservation Studio includes integrated image markup tools, allowing you to highlight an area of deterioration and include condition notes and comments directly on an image. Your markup can be as simple or complex as required.

## MULTI-PART OBJECT MANAGEMENT

Handle multi-part objects that require different conservation treatments with detailed accuracy. For example, you can now easily manage a complex piece of furniture or a suit of armor, which consists of multiple pieces, some metal and some textile.
