



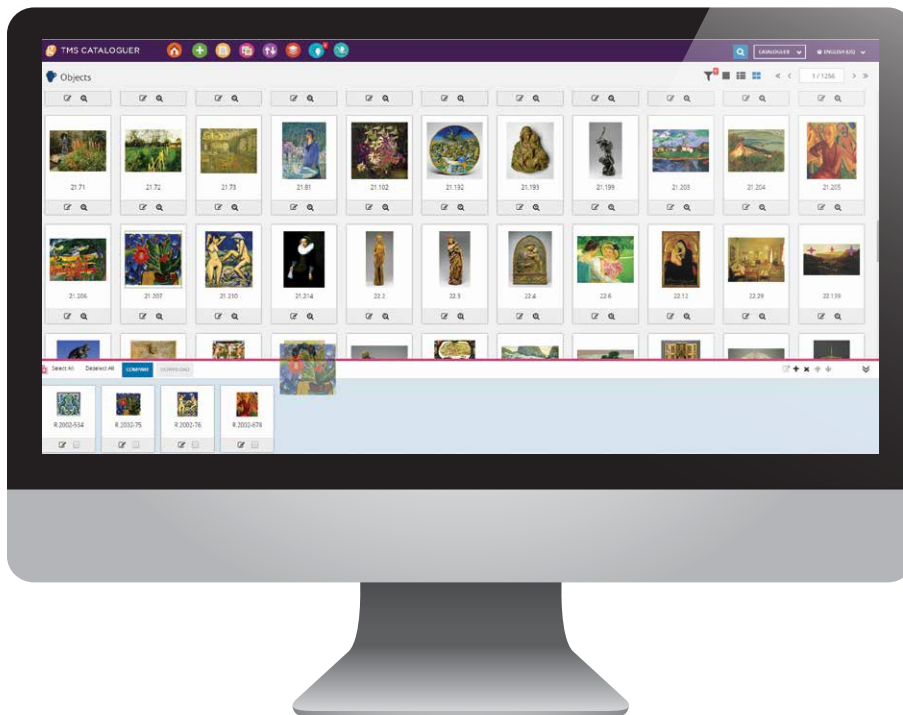

TMS CATALOGUER CORE MODULES



Objects

Capture and manage information about the objects in your collection; track data about acquisitions and accessioning, de-accessioning, dimensions, research notes, provenance, locations, and more.



Exhibitions

Plan, manage, and document exhibitions and display rotations.



Constituents

Create records for organizations and individuals related to your collection, including artists and makers, borrowers, lenders, donors, shipping agents, and others. Constituent records can be cross-referenced to all of the modules in TMS Cataloguer.



Loans

Manage outgoing and incoming loans, including related legal and financial processes.



Media

TMS Cataloguer provides a range of media functionality and supports most common media file formats.
