

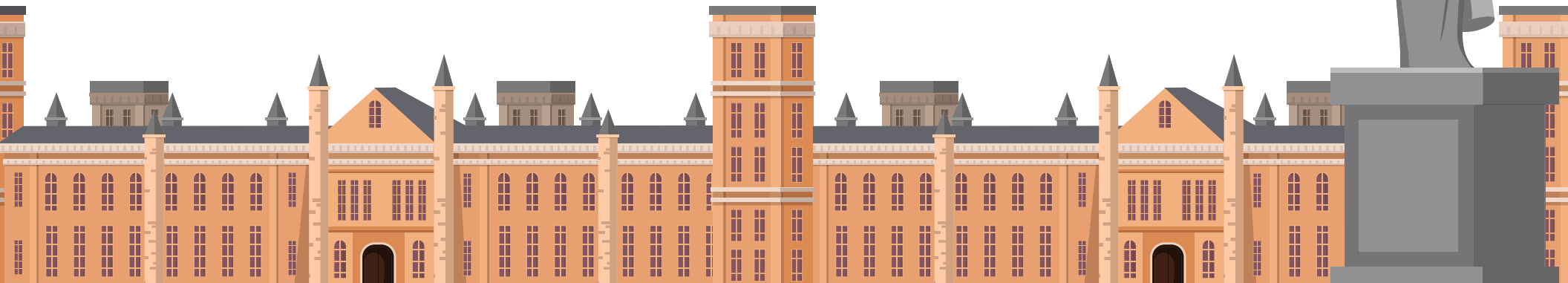
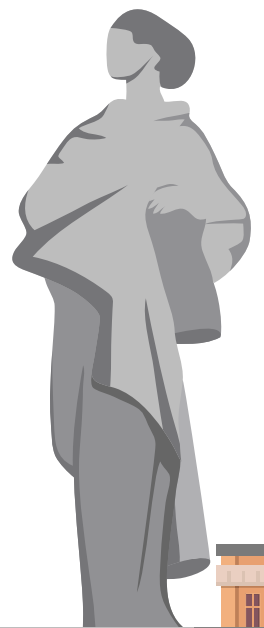

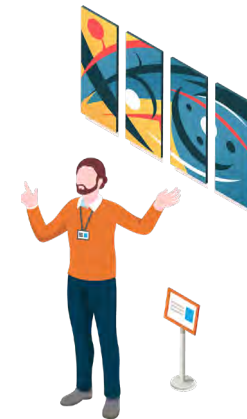




## Grants for Canadian Museums and Cultural Institutions

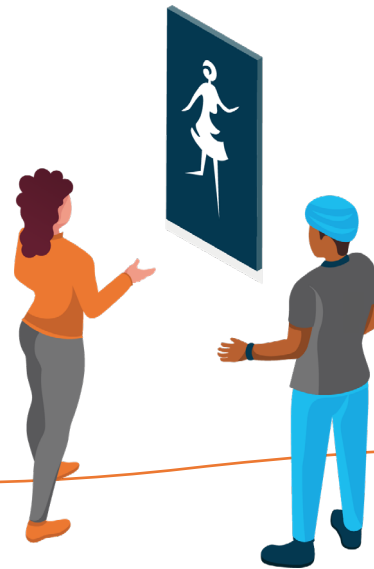

The Canada Travelling Exhibitions Indemnification Program encourages the use of lending programs across Canada to fulfill two key objectives. First, to promote the access and exchange of cultural artifacts and exhibitions throughout Canada. And second, to provide Canadian institutions with the means to promote international exhibitions. The program assigns the financial risk and responsibility of damaged or lost objects to the **Government of Canada** by providing compensation, should loss or damage occur.

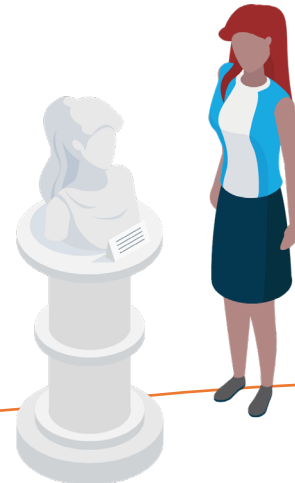

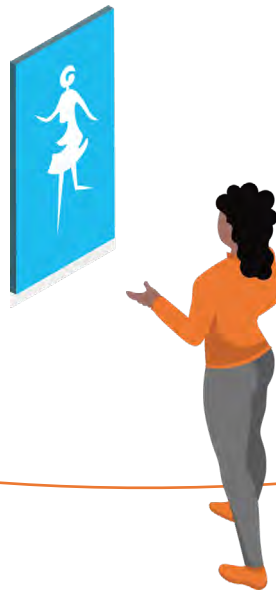

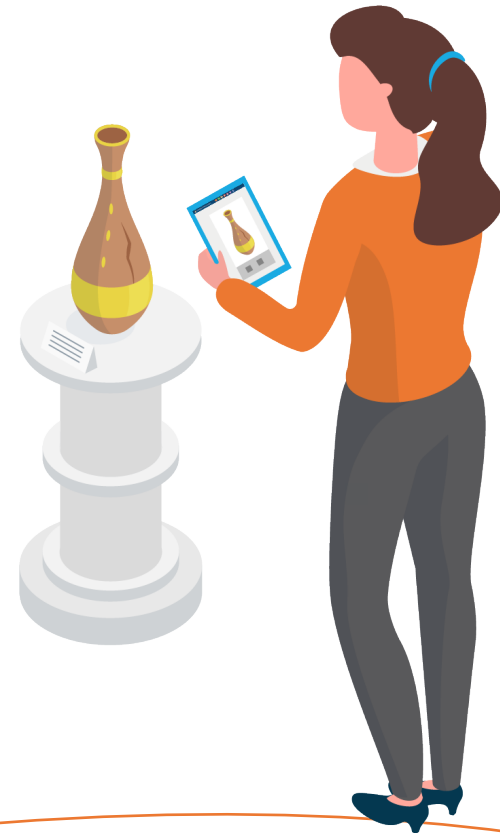

To remain in the program, a museum must undergo an evaluation every three years, maintain a minimum score, and submit an annual report outlining operating costs for its last complete fiscal year.

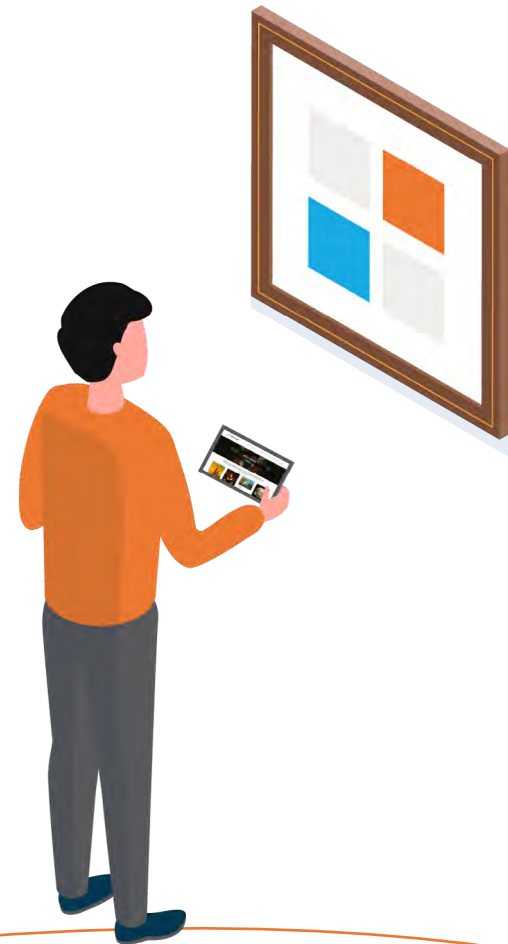

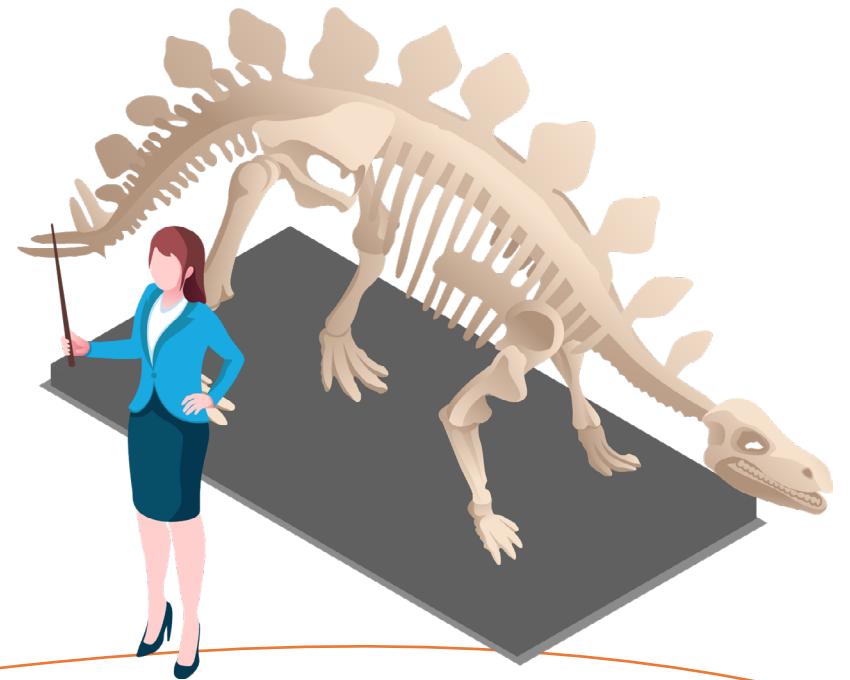

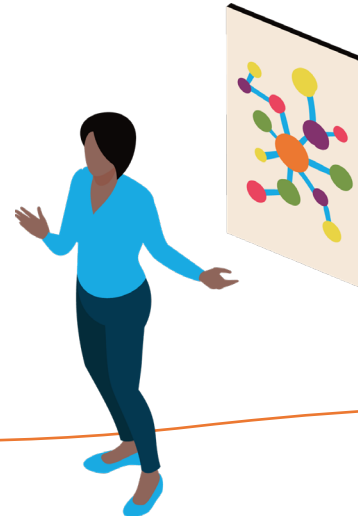
